



# DENTON RESERVOIR LOOP

WATERY WAYS

Canals need a constant supply of water.

Where local rivers and streams were unreliable, reservoirs were built to store water.

Every time a boat went through the nearby Woolsthorpe locks thousands of gallons of water were lost along the canal. To replace it, water was released into the canal from Denton Reservoir. Because the reservoir is higher than the canal the released water flows by gravity into the canal
